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# HOW WILL IT WORK?

-  Activities will run from 3.30 – 4.25pm, Monday – Friday.
-  Activities will begin in week 2 of the Autumn, Spring and Summer Terms.
-  There will be no activities in the final week of any term.
-  Each child may choose a maximum of two activities per week.
-  The number of spaces for each activity is limited. Waiting lists will be held where necessary for the current term only.
-  Details of clubs will be reissued at the end of each term and at this time children choose their choice of activity for the following term. Please note that children attending Ballet and Judo classes will automatically continue in the class for the year unless notice has been given to Mrs Cortez or Mr Gould.
-  An extra charge will only be made for those activities operated by external providers. The fees for these are quoted in this leaflet.
-  In the event of an activity having to be cancelled, parents will be contacted by the school.
-  At the end of this booklet are details on how to apply online for the activities. Please do this by Monday 1 December 2025.
